For more than 94 years, the British Columbia 4-H Program has been providing a strong foundation of positive ideals for rural youth to live by as they become our future leaders.

To ensure the continuing success of the B.C. 4-H movement, we need your help. Your support of the British Columbia 4-H Foundation today is a sound investment in the future of our rural youth, the communities in which they live and B.C. agribusiness.



What is 4-H?

- a community-based organization dedicated to the personal growth and development of farm and non-farm rural youth and volunteer adult leaders.
- focuses on both technical skill development related to agriculture, as well as life skills such as citizenship, leadership, cooperation and responsibility.
- in British Columbia there are more than 3500 4-H members and 1000 volunteer leaders who make up close to 250 4-H clubs.
- club projects range from beef, horse, dog and goat to outdoor living, crafts and clothing.
- there are four basic levels to the 4-H structure:

B.C. 4-H Provincial Council
 Regional 4-H Councils
 District 4-H Councils
 4-H Clubs

What is the Role of the British Columbia 4-H Foundation?

- not-for-profit organization which operates as the “investment arm” of the B.C. 4-H Provincial Council. The Provincial Council is responsible for administration, management, policy-making and public relations for the B.C. 4-H Program.
- provides an opportunity for interested individuals, organizations and companies to contribute financially to the B.C. 4-H Program.
- invests these contributions in perpetuity with the interest going back to 4-H to support new and existing programs and services.

How Do I Contribute?

Donations in any amount are welcome. Individuals and businesses may choose to contribute to the 4-H Foundation on an annual basis or through a one time only donation. Individuals may also choose to provide long term support to the Foundation by granting a bequest in their will, naming the Foundation as the beneficiary of their insurance policy or through memorial donations.

All donations to the British Columbia 4-H Foundation are acknowledged with a charitable tax receipt, a listing in the annual report and appropriate certificates or pins of appreciation.

Wills and Bequests

A bequest in your will to the British Columbia 4-H Foundation will play a valuable role in supporting the worthwhile goals of the 4-H Program and will help to make a difference in the future of our rural youth, the communities in which they live and continuation of the rural way of life. All it takes is a simple clause:

“I direct my Trustee to give to the British Columbia 4-H Foundation the sum of \$_____ from my estate.”

Memorial Donations

Memorial donations are contributions made to the British Columbia 4-H Foundation in the name of a deceased individual. The family may indicate a donation to 4-H in lieu of flowers. A Foundation memorial donation is a fitting tribute to anyone who has been committed to rural British Columbia, agriculture or the 4-H movement.
